I FLOWER BRACELET ASSEMBLED WITH RUBBER BANDS

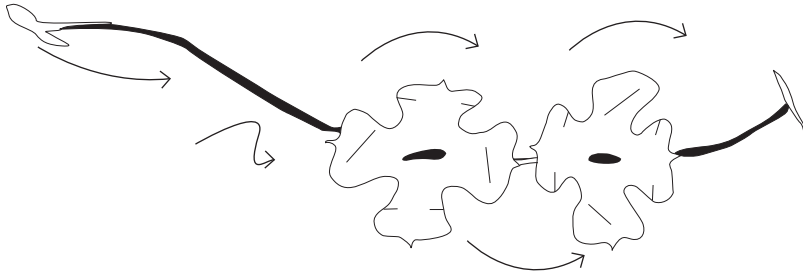

Thread onto the rubber band as many flower elements as you wish.

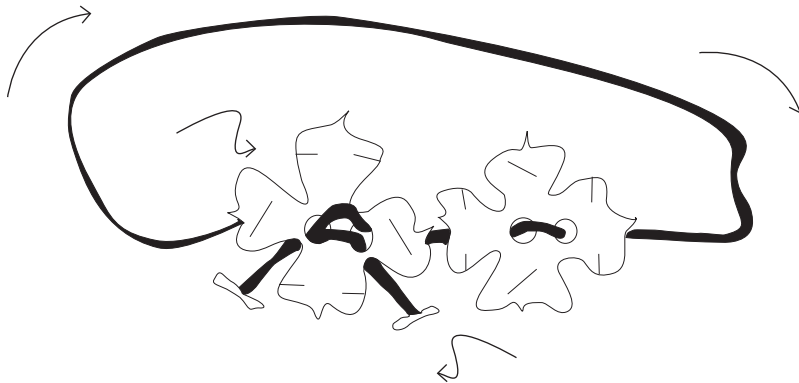

For instance, a headband might need 5 elements, a bracelet may need 3 to 6 elements.

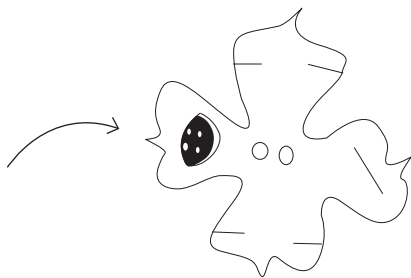

Once all elements are added, thread the end of the rubber band as indicated twice through the first flower. This closes the band into the circular band. The end pieces of the rubber band work like cufflinks.

II FLOWERKIT TO PLUG OVER BUTTON

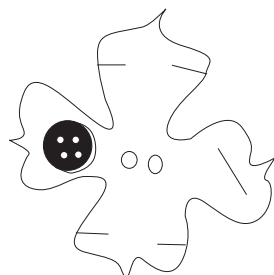

Make sure, the size of your existing buttons goes with the slit size. If the buttons are too large, sew smaller buttons onto your gloves or coats.

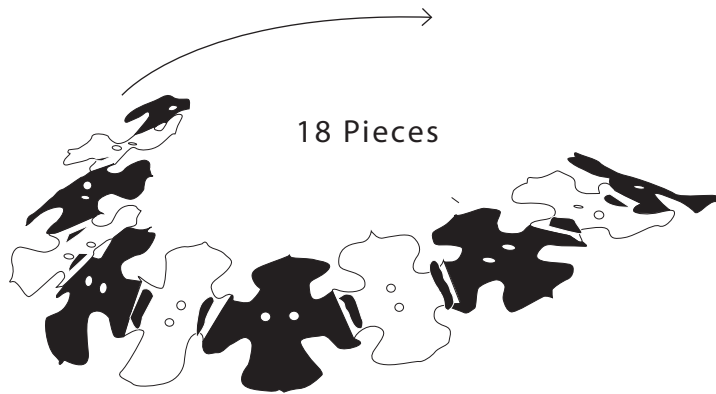

Pull the flower element over the button.

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III FLOWERKIT TO PLUG AS NECKLACE

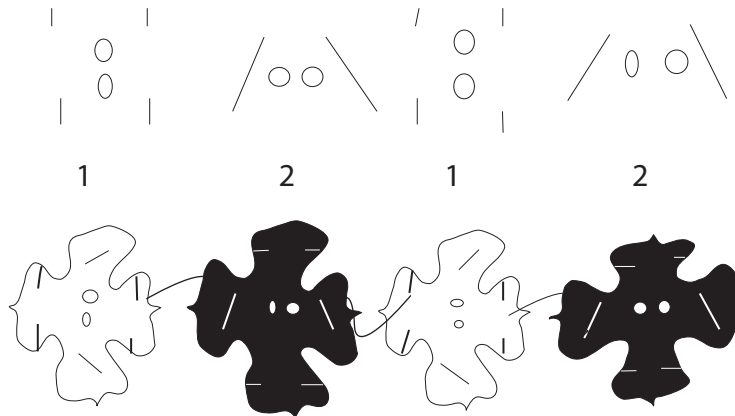

To be large enough for getting it over your head, the necklace needs to have at least 18 elements. It can also be larger, but needs an even number of elements. For every other element you can use another colour, with the reflective side facing up

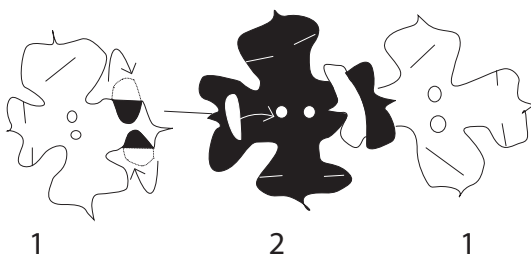

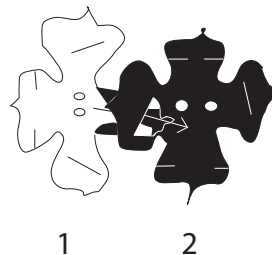

To assemble, lay the flowerkit elements out so that the small slits are perpendicular to the neckless. (1) the big slits looking like trapeze with the wide side facing you. (2) (See illustration)

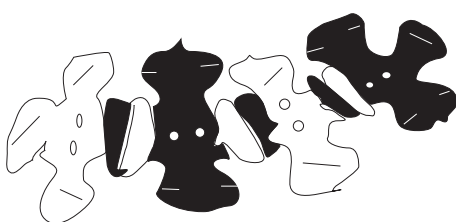

The leaves of the flower elements with two small slits need to be folded forward, as indicated on drawing. Then push them through the big slits of the neighbour element.

The connected elements now form a chain that becomes a larger circular neckless
